### **4<sup>th</sup> Annual ONSF Lab and Clinical Instruction Collaboration with Norwalk Community College**

GREENWICH, CT – The 4<sup>th</sup> Annual **ONSF** Lab and Clinical Instruction Collaboration with Norwalk Community College will take place on March 30<sup>th</sup> and 31<sup>st</sup> and again on April 20<sup>th</sup> and 21<sup>st</sup>. The course, designed exclusively for the NCC physical therapy students' Kinesiology class, and will take place at the **ONSF** Arthroscopy, Surgical Skills and Biomechanical Research Laboratory in Greenwich. The program is titled "Observation of Upper and Lower Extremity Dissection with Clinical Instruction." Approximately 19 students will have the unique opportunity to observe and engage in dissections in addition to receiving clinical instruction. Dr. Paul Sethi, Orthopedic Surgeon and President of **ONSF** and other surgeons will mentor the students.
